## **Helpful Tips for Your Music Video**

- 1. Pick an easy song. Use a song with clear lyrics, a storyline and uses visual images in the song.
- 2. Print out the lyrics to your song. Copy and paste the lyrics for your treatment to send into the website.
- 3. Learn the lyrics of the song. Just because you think you know they lyrics, that does not mean you KNOW the lyrics!
- 4. When lip synching, you should actually SING the words. This enhances the production.
- 5. Don't pick a RAP song if you cannot RAP as fast as the singer....it will look silly!
- 6. Make SURE that the camera and the singer can hear the music clearly.
- 7. The closer the music source is to the camera, the EASIER it will be to edit later
- 8. DO NOT chew gum in your production.
- 9. You cannot take music form your iphone or ipod and load it into our macs. You must get the song on a flashdrive from your HOME itunes!
- 10. Make sure you hit record, then countdown in loud clear voice...AND 5,4,3,2....
- 11. Shoot the ENTIRE song all the way through at least 3 times, one wide, one medium, one close up.
- 12. Shoot "B" roll or a storyline.
- 13. Allow smooth camera movement.
- 14. Spend 1 to 2 class periods shooting the ENTIRE song all the way through
- 15. Bring your song (the EXACT version you lip synched to) into itunes on your edit system
- 16. Load in ALL your footage as soon as possible
- 17. Synch up your song to the videos in your timelime with your Wide shot on track one, your medium shot on track two, and your tight shot on track three.
- 18. Put your "B" roll footage on track 4
- 19. Use the Blade tool to cut away the video you DO NOT want to see.
- 20. When everything is edited, you may start to add color and special effects.
